## From Beehive to Han-Stein: The Trading Post at Camp Eastman



**Inside the Beehive in the 1960's**

tion of Eastman Lodge in 1935. That building was sited behind the present Eastman Lodge, and pictures show the Lodge being constructed in front of it.

For several years in the 70's, the Beehive area was unofficially re-named Han-Stein Plaza, after two of the most famous Camp Eastman capitalists, Steve Hanlin and Neil Klopfenstein, took over the trading post duties. For several years their mix of madcap advertising, crazy giveaways and shameless self-promotions made the Trading Post an even more popular (and profitable) destination than normal.

In the early 1980's, the Trading Post was moved to its current location in the front of the Admin building. By 1985, the original Beehive building had been demolished. A project to add a 40 foot pad and shelter to the Trading Post building was funded and constructed by the Camp Eastman Development Association in 2001. This year CEDA completed a structure to house the pop and ice machines.

The concrete block building known as the Beehive was built in 1943 by Mrs. Eastman. The origins of the name are unknown, but it is generally assumed the name refers to the Trading Post area being a "beehive" of activity.

Prior to the opening of the Beehive Trading Post, there seems to have been a "canteen" area with an outside service window in the wood frame building that was used as a dining hall prior to the comple-

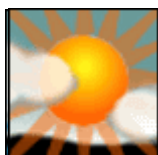

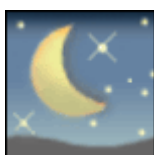

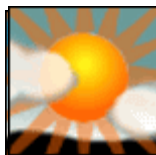
